Cookie Donations

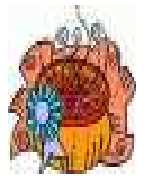

During the next several weeks, our students and staff will be joining with other schools in our deanery to support the work of Father Rick Frechette, a Passionist Missionary, who ministers in two hospitals in Haiti. Father Rick is both a priest and a doctor. He also works alongside the Missionaries of Charity (Mother Teresa's Religious Order) in their center for the sick and destitute dying. Not only are we collecting monetary donations, but we are praying daily for a people who are facing unimaginable suffering and physical pain. Our daily coin collection is now underway. This is just one small effort in our response to the poverty and misery so many of our Haitian brothers and sisters face day to day.

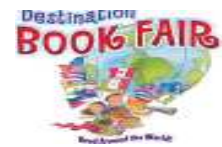
