Dear Parents of Current 6th Grade Students:

There is a new immunization requirement announced by the Ohio Department of Health for the 2010-2011 school year. I have included information from the ODH with this notice.

“Schools will have new immunization requirements for the 2010-2011 school year from the Ohio Department of Health (ODH). As you may remember, the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3313.67 and 3313.671 indicates that schools are responsible for ensuring that students who enroll in school have immunizations required by ODH. The statute also states that schools are to keep records of the immunizations.”

The most significant change is the addition of a DPT (diphtheria, pertussis and tetanus) booster for the 2010-11 seventh-grade students. It is not too early to call your child’s doctor and schedule an appointment for the required DPT immunization he/she must have before entering seventh grade at any school in the State of Ohio.

There is a 4-day “grace” period which allows a student to attend school for the first 4 days without the immunization. However, after 4 days the student will not be able to return until the immunization has been received. This rule applies to all age and interval minimums and the rule will be enforced at All Saints Catholic School.

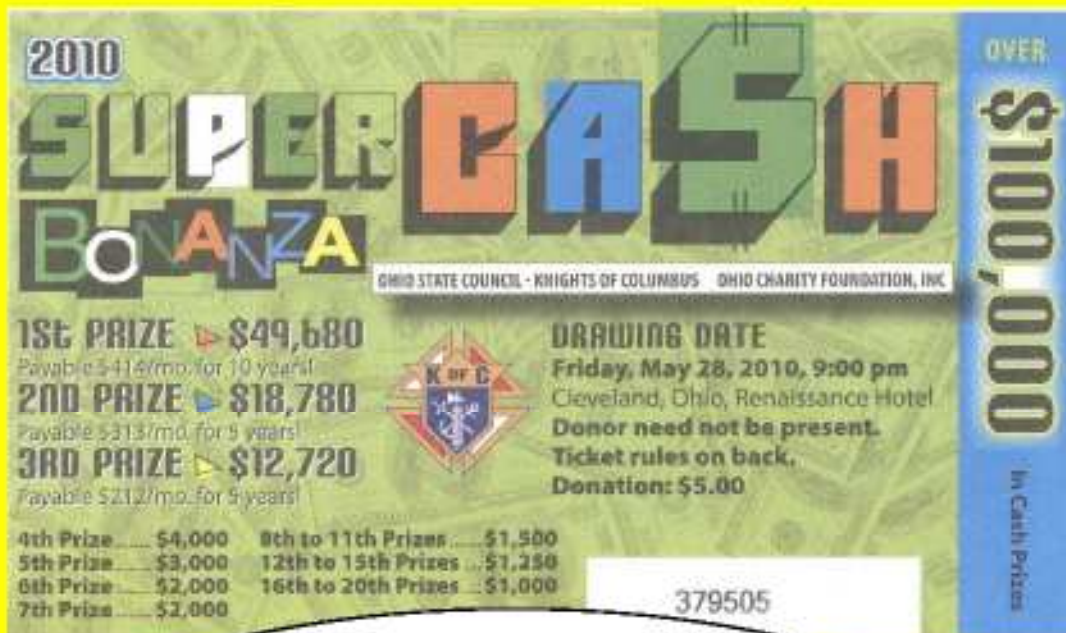
