Our Lenten Journey

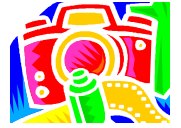

And, of course, remember to send those cookies. The "cookie table" makes for a very warm greeting to our visitors and substance for those giving their time.



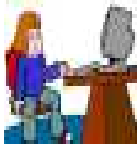
Registration for 2010-11

Registration packets for next school year were sent home last week. Enclosed was important information including forms and due dates. If you did not receive your packet, please call the office. Reminder: enrollment forms and registration fee are due before Friday, March 12. Beginning Monday, March 15, classes will be opened up to new families interested in enrolling their children at All Saints. If you know that your student(s) will not be returning to All Saints, please call Mrs. Tangeman (419-661-2070) or email her at mtangeman@allsaintscatholic.org.

Tuition Assistance for 2010-11 requests are also due before Friday, March 12. To be eligible for tuition assistance from All Saints, parents/guardians must be an "active parishioner" at All Saints in addition to the following:

- 1) Complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Assessment
- 2) Completed enrollment forms and registration fee are sent to office.
- 3) If not paying in full, FACTS Payment Plan form must be returned to the office.
- 4) Complete One Faith Many Blessings Scholarship form and return to the office.
Form is now available in the school.
- 5) Complete Northwest Ohio Children's Scholarship form and return to the office.

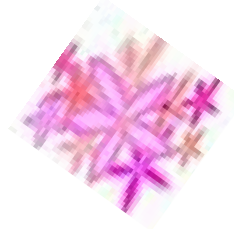
