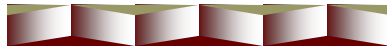

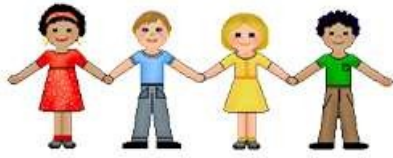

Steps to Respect: Creating a Safe & Positive Learning Environment



What is *bullying*?

In *Steps to Respect*, children learn the following definition: Bullying is unfair and one-sided. It happens when someone keeps hurting, frightening, threatening, or leaving someone out on purpose.

Bullying may consist of hitting, teasing, taunting, spreading rumors and gossip, stealing, and excluding someone from a group. It is carried out with the intent to harm someone.

Bullying is often a repeated activity. However, bullying behaviors may also occur as a one-time event. Bullying always involves a power imbalance. The person bullying has more power due to such factors as age, size, strength, support of friends, and access to resources (such as toys and other belongings).

As I was looking over the information on the Emergency Medical and Transportation Authorization forms, I noticed many parents/guardians did not include information regarding your child's current medications, allergies, or other pertinent past medical history in the space provided for such information. Several students who have had allergies or medical conditions listed in the past, did not have this information listed on this form this school year.

Please take the time to send me an email (clada@allsaintscatholic.org) or a hand-written note regarding **any daily or as needed medications your child is currently taking, any medical conditions your child may have and/or any type of allergies, especially food allergies your child may have**. It is **very important** to have this information should your child need emergency medical attention while at school.

If your child is sick and will be absent, please remember to call the school office before 9:00 am to report your child's absence. When you call, please let us know the reason for your child's illness. This will help us to monitor "what's going around" at All Saints Catholic School.

When your child returns to school after being absent, a parent/guardian note must accompany your child regarding the reason for his/her absence.
