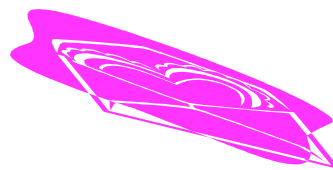

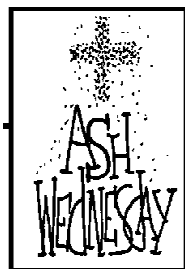

Students in preschool through eighth grade may register for the 2010-11 school year. Registration packets containing FACTS Grant and Aid Application and Northwest Ohio Scholarship information will be available.

Students from low-income families who reside in Lucas, Wood, or Fulton County have an opportunity to be awarded need-based scholarships up to \$1,250 per child so that students in Kindergarten through Grade 8 can attend a private school. The Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund is accepting applications for its annual scholarship lottery for 2010-2011.
