Registration for 2010-2011

It is hard to believe that this school year is winding down. Registration packets for next school year were sent home today with your oldest child. Enclosed in the packet you will find important information including forms and due dates. For your convenience, last year's enrollment form has been copied. Please make necessary changes to the form, especially address, phone numbers, email addresses, etc. So that the changes stand out and are not overlooked, it would be helpful to make corrections in **red** or **blue** ink. You may also use highlighters. Make sure the back side is signed and this year's date is added. Additional enrollment forms for siblings are available in the school office or on our website.

FACTS Grant and Aid Applications, FACTS Payment Forms, and Northwest Ohio Scholarship Application are also included in the envelope. If you were enrolled in FACTS for 2009-10, your re-enrollment form is enclosed. All you need to do is verify the information (especially banking), make necessary changes, sign, and return with your registration fee and enrollment forms.

All families requesting tuition assistance must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Application. No decisions can be made until this process is completed. Tuition assistance guidelines are included in the packet.

Also included in the packet are two brochures, two postcards, and two bookmarks. Please pass these along to families who may be interested in All Saints Catholic School.
