

**All Saints Catholic School
2010-2011 School Year**

During Catholic Schools Week (January 30 through February 7, 2010), Bishop Leonard P. Blair released a video describing the many challenges facing Catholic schools in the Diocese of Toledo. In the video, Bishop Blair praised the quality of religious instruction as well as excellent academics resulting in graduation rates higher than the state average for public high school students.

Bishop Blair also cited some disturbing trends that adversely affect our Catholic schools and even threaten their future. Compared to 10 years ago, the Diocese of Toledo has experienced a 26% decline in the number of students enrolled. The changing economy and demographics in northwest Ohio, as well as fewer Catholics practicing their faith, also contribute to declining enrollment. An analysis of 2008-09 revenues showed that 54.4% of All Saints Parish collection or 36.6% of total parish revenue was allocated to our school. As explained in our parish and school newsletters, state funding has also declined.

We are well aware that tuition has steadily increased over the years to meet rising costs. Included in the budget for the 2010-2011 school year is a \$100 per student tuition increase. Tuition assistance for eligible families remains available. You will find information about the tuition assistance application process in the registration packet and on the school website (www.allsaintscatholic.org).

The enrollment application and registration fee is due to the school office by Friday, March 12, 2010, for all families currently enrolled at All Saints Catholic School.

In an effort to maintain a regular cash flow, All Saints Catholic School will continue to use a tuition payment plan through FACTS. We believe this plan provides reasonable choices for families and increases financial stability by avoiding unpaid tuition bills which increase the overall cost of operating the school. The FACTS Program services many schools like ours throughout the Toledo Diocese. Families have the option to pay their school tuition in one of the following ways:

Option 1: **Full Payment of Tuition** paid directly to the school by **Friday, May 7, 2010.**

Option 2: **Monthly Payments** (July-April) through **FACTS Tuition Payment Plan.**

* Families who choose Option 2 will pay the Non-Prepaid Tuition Rate.

The brochure and enclosed paperwork from FACTS Management Company explains the program in detail. If your family should experience an unexpected financial crisis, please contact the school office as soon as possible. The FACTS plan is very flexible and can be adjusted if necessary.

**All current families must be prepaid or enrolled in the FACTS Tuition Payment Plan by May 7, 2010.
Tuition payments received after May 7, 2010, will be billed at the non-prepaid rate.
Enrollment is not complete until tuition is paid in full or
FACTS Automatic Bank Payment Plan enrollment is completed.**
